Co-Teaching Institute

The Special School District and the St. Louis RPDC are co-sponsoring a 2-day institute on maximizing the effectiveness of co-taught classrooms. She is the author of *The Co-Teaching Lesson Plan Book* and featured presenter for two DVDs, *7 Effective Strategies for Secondary Inclusion* and *Winning Strategies for Effective Inclusion*. She has published numerous articles on co-teaching, technology and secondary inclusion, including "50 Ways to Keep your Co-Teacher."
