Introduction to Emergency Incident Preparedness and Planning

This tailor-made course will provide the participants with information to consider when analyzing threats, preparing response plans, and testing their plans for applicability. It is course material extracted from the more comprehensive FEMA "Multi-Hazard Planning for Schools" course as well as other relevant information sources. It will include information for responses to weather anomalies as well as research sites for additional information. The participants will tour the Emergency Operations Center as part of the class.
